SLD-1 Camera SLED is a shoulder mount rig for offering comfortable and professional operation. It perfectly accommodates many popular cameras from major camera manufacturers.


Equipped with rear V-mount battery plate, the SLD-1 Camera SLED has extra power options and allows for other accessories to be mounted to the back like AD-2 adaptor. There is also a D-Tap connector to supply power to camera.

A USB port is included to supply power to LED light. Also, two bi-color tally LED lights are provided to serve as indications to the camera crew.






	USB Port	The USB port serves as the LED Light power supply when AD-2 Adaptor is mounted.


### 3. Quick Camera Removal

Follow the steps outlined below to remove the camera from SLED.




A: Loosen the rotary knob by turning it in an anti-clockwise direction.

B: Push the lock pin in the direction as shown in the diagram.




# 4. Optional Power Board









**Camera and V-Mount Battery** 





